The checklist below is important for whatever workplace that has forklifts on the premises. Each of these questions should be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural flaw that can lead to injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) The forklift tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to utilize the equipment?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any machine damage and forklift accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed on a daily basis prior to the equipment being operated?
