Introduction

A successful and safe warehouse operation is one that is orderly and efficient. The warehouse employee is necessary in ensuring that supplies are circulated throughout the facility in a timely and efficient method. Because of the numerous activities involved in warehouse operations, employees in warehouse environment might be at greater risk for accidents as opposed to those who work in areas with more limited activities. Thus, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse hazards is key to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to potential hazards and methods to lessen risks. Do whatever is required to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are normally caused when workers lose their balance or stumble over an item that has not been put away properly. Removing or placing objects from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, possibly causing both employee and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when workers are moving supplies on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting methods are one more common hazard.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent hazards. Injuries or accidents can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, need to be used cautiously in loading, packing and unpacking.

Dangerous substances, combustible or flammable materials could pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around dangerous materials.
