Theory Programs

Theory course topics: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; rigging knowledge; crane operation knowledge; crane rigging charts; communications knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane service and maintenance and crane pre-trip inspections & set-u.

Practical Programs

The crane training school features practical training involving hands-on learning. This part teaches trainees how to identify crane terminology and components. Trainees will have the chance to perform skills considered necessary for crane signaling, operating and signaling.

The topics included in the practical part includes: Learn crane terms; identify crane functions and components; identify rigging and wire ropes; utilize remote control; pre-use inspection on crane; identify documents and regulations for wire rope and rigging; use hand signals and radio; carry out right lowering and lifting of loads and carry out rigging techniques.
